### **Composite Technician**

### **Job Duties and Responsibilities:**

Under little or no supervision, perform one or more of the following composite part manufacturing functions: Complex lay-up, cutting, bagging, trimming, vacuum infusion, and/or complex repairs. Prepare composite samples for testing and carry out tests as directed. Function as a team member and provide technical direction for the improvement of processes. Able to prioritize tasks and communicate timelines of objectives frequently.

- In a team oriented work environment, repair and manufacture a variety of composite parts to meet manufacturing specifications. Possess the ability to perform close tolerance work.
